

POSITION: **Crisis Intervention Associate's or Bachelor's Level Intern**
SUPERVISOR(S): Clinical Services Director or Designee
TIME FRAME: 1 + Semesters

QUALIFICATIONS:

The Bachelor level intern shall be enrolled in a 2 or 4-year university or college Social Work, Counseling, Psychology, or related program. This intern shall demonstrate: competency in working with people from different cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds; ability to work independently and as a part of team; and ability to communicate effectively with colleagues and clients. Experience working with youth and families is preferred.

OVERVIEW OF POSITION:

This position is responsible to assist in the provision of crisis intervention services.

DESCRIPTION OF GENERAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: :

The following are general responsibilities of the position after demonstrated competency and sufficient preparation:

- Complete one weekly 4-hour shift on the agency's crisis line, providing telephone crisis intervention and referral services to youth, families, and others in need
- Complete follow-up calls to youth and their families who have exited services within the past 12 months;
- Administer follow-up calls to former service recipients;
- Attend all ongoing in-service crisis intervention trainings/meetings;
- Complete other duties, as assigned by supervisor
