The Education Project works to ensure students in homelessness and temporary living situations enroll, regularly attend and succeed in school. During the 2014-2015 school year, we served more than 1300 students in Washtenaw County, ages 0-21, from the 10 school districts and nine public school academies in the county. Every single school district in the county is working with students in temporary living situations.
