Providing a few basic necessities to call their space their own, goes a long way. These young people stay with us up to a year and a half as they learn life-skills to live on their own for the very first time.

It's suggested that each Welcome Kit contain:
(Gender Neutral items are suggested so that we can utilize items for everyone)

- Twin Comforter
- Twin Sheet Set
- Pillow Case
- 2 Shower towels
- 2 Hand towels
- 2 Washcloths
- Shower Caddy
- Journal with pen(s) or pencils
- Organizer/planner

Want to build a bigger kit? Great! Other helpful items are hygiene products and personal items, such as: Deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo/conditioner, underwear, undershirts, combs/brushes, chapstick, floss sticks, African American hair products, and menstrual supplies.
